

February Book Report

After you have independently read a book on your level, you will create a puzzle as your book report:





- 2. On piece #1 should be a <u>creative</u> display of the <u>title</u> and <u>author</u> of the book as well as <u>your name</u>.
- 3. Piece #2 should list the <u>main character and other important characters</u> in your book as well as include a <u>picture</u> of the main character.
- 4. Piece #3 should tell the reader about the <u>setting</u> of the book and include a <u>picture</u>.
- 5. Piece #4 should tell the reader the problem of the book.
- 6. Piece #5 should tell the reader one of the main events of the book.
- 7. Piece #6 should tell the reader <u>another of the main events</u> of the book.
- 8. Piece #7 should tell the reader about the <u>climax</u> of the book. (Remember, the climax is the part of the story where everything is the most messed up. It is the turning point of the story.)
- 9. Piece #8 should give a <u>hint</u> of the solution of the problem but not give away the ending.
- 10. Piece #9 should be your personal rating of the book.
- 11. Mount your puzzle on a piece of construction paper.
- 12. Decorate the edges of the construction paper in the theme of your book. (In other words, give it a border on the construction paper.)
- 13. Outline your illustrations in black sharpie or pen to make them "pop."


Piece #9 gives a personal rating of the book (1-5 with 1 being worst and 5 being best).
