The Brown Bag Book Report is due _____.

This month you will read a book of your choice that is on your reading level and that you have not yet read. When you finish the book, you will—

1. Take the AR Test on the book.
2. Display the title and author on the front of a grocery bag. Make sure the print or font is large enough to see from the back of the room. In other words, the words should take up most of the front of the bag.
3. Prepare a bag of 7-10 objects that will help you tell about the book. These should be 3-dimensional items. (Please, no more than 1 photo/picture.)
4. Prepare flashcards or notes to tell about each part of the story. Practice your presentation at home.
5. You will give a short oral presentation (no more than 4 minutes) about the book you read, pulling objects out of the bag to help you tell about different parts of the story.
